Since 1947, **Youth of the Year** has been Boys & Girls Club of America's premier recognition program, celebrating the extraordinary achievements of Club teens. Club members who earn the Youth of the Year title embody the values of leadership service; academic excellence; and healthy lifestyles.

Candidates ages 14-18 from all 9 clubhouses on Kauai and Oahu attend the Youth of the Year Academy. This 3 ½ month program is facilitated by our Alliance Board members, Club staff, and volunteers. The teens are coached, mentored, and trained in all areas of competition - speech, essay writing and interview.

The winner of the BGCH competition (Jan. 26, 2019) will then compete against the winner of BGC Maui and BGC Big Island for the **2019 Hawaii State Youth of the Year** title.

That winner goes on to compete in the Pacific Regional competition in July 2019.
